Opti-Loc Mounting System


Instruction Manual

The Opti-Loc can be positioned to the left or right of the badge as needed.


Please read the following instructions for proper removal and attachment of the Opti-Loc.

Removing the Opti-Loc

1. Remove the Batter Side Hoop and Head from the drum. Using a Drum Key, remove the Key Nut and Fiber Washer as shown (Fig. 1).



Lift and remove the Opti-Loc from the drum as shown (Fig. 2).



3. Hold the Rubber Isolator to keep it from spinning and use a Drum Key to remove the Key Bolt, Washer, and Spacer as shown (Fig. 3).



Attaching the Opti-Loc

There's an Air Vent on each side of the Badge. Attach
the Rubber Isolator through the appropriate Air Vent as
shown (Figs. 4-A and 4-B). Do not overtighten the Key
Bolt



5. Attach the Opti-Loc as shown. Make sure that the Rubber Grommets and the Lug Nuts are aligned and fitted as shown. Secure the bottom leg of the Opti-Loc to the Rubber Isolater with the Fiber Washer and Key Nut as shown (Fig. 5). Do not overtighten the Key Nut.



6. Attach the Batter Side Drum Head and Hoop to the drum in the order shown (Fig. 6).



Note

- Removing or Attaching the Opti-Loc in a way other than described in this Manual can cause damage to the Opti-Loc.
- •Do not carry the drum by the Opti-Loc unless the Batter Side Hoop and Head are attached. Doing so can cause the Opti-Loc to fall off and cause injury and/or damage to the Opti-Loc and the drum.
- Make sure not to misplace the parts when removing the Opti-Loc.
