## **PEARL PERCUSSION / PBS-30BD**

## Set-up Instructions for Pearl Brazilian Surdo Leg and Bass Drum Adaptor Kit


The PBS-30BD adds legs to drums such as Pearl Surdos so they can be played vertically like drum set "floor toms" or horizontally like "bass drums". Each kit consist of (3) Brackets, (3) Legs, and a Pedal Attachment Plate with bolts.






## **Vertical "Floor Tom" Style Position:**


- 1) Stand the drum vertically with the drum head that's played facing UP.
- 2) Loosen the wing nut on the hook and clip the hook around a tension post about 3" from the bottom (A). Tighten the wing nut securely but don't overtighten (B).



Note: Make sure the tension post is squarely seated in the "V" Notch.



3) Attach the other two brackets in the same manner per the diagram below



4) Insert the legs into the bracket as shown and tighten the wing nuts.



5) Stand the drum upright and adjust the length of the legs (A) to achieve the desired height and angle. The bracket can also be moved along the length of the tension post (B).




## Horizontal "Bass Drum" Style Position

1) Attach the Pedal Attachment Plate to the "ears" as shown and tighten the bolts securely.

Note: The bolts may differ from those shown.




2) Lay the drum on its side with the "audience-side" drum head facing toward you as shown. Attach the brackets to the indicated tension posts (A).





3) Insert a leg through the Forward Hole and through the Eye Hook (A). Push the leg further until it rests in the center of the "V" Notch (B) and tighten the wing nut.



4) Adjust the length of the legs to square and support the drum.

Note: The angle of the drum can be adjusted by telescoping the legs (A). The bracket (B) can be positioned along the tension posts as needed to fit the drum on shallow stages or risers.



5) Attach the pedal to the Pedal Attachment Plate.
